Fungal nail infections affect more than a million people in the UK, men are more likely to suffer than women, and toenails are four times more likely to be affected than finger nails.

What is fungal nail?

When a nail is infected by a fungus the nails become discoloured and thickened in appearance. The nails may become brittle and flaky and the colour of the nails can present as white, black, yellow or green. There may be no pain in the initial stages of the fungal infection and if left can lead to further tissue damage which will prolong healing. Foot odour may be present.

Why is it so difficult to get rid of?

One of the biggest challenges to treatment is being able to readily access and reach the source of the infection in the nail bed. For years, practitioners worldwide have been challenged with the common problem of onychomycosis, or fungal nail infection.

Traditional over-the-counter treatments are ineffective because the active ingredients usually cannot penetrate to the whole of the infection. Prescription medications can be offered which have unpleasant side effects. For the person affected with the fungal nail it can mean months or years of unsightly and often uncomfortable nails. By providing direct access to the source of the site of infection allows topical applications to clear the infection in a much shorter time by comparison to the other conventional methods.
